

What is Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)?

Household products that can present a hazard to our health and our environment when not properly used, stored, and disposed of are considered Household Hazardous Waste.

The Redwood County HHW Facility accepts hazardous materials from residents of Redwood County for NO CHARGE.

Transporting HHW

- Keep products in their original containers
- Do not mix products
- Make sure lids are sealed tightly
- Label materials if original label is missing or unreadable
- Keep flammables out of direct sunlight and away from sources of heat, spark, flame, or ignition

- ⊗ Explosives - Contact the Redwood Falls Police Department or Redwood County Sheriff's Office
- ⊗ Used Oil - Take to the County Hwy Shop or City Maintenance Shop
- ⊗ Oil Filters - Take to an automotive repair shop or County Hwy Dept
- ⊗ Automotive Batteries - Take to retailers that sell car batteries
- ⊗ Business Waste - Call the Lyon County Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 507-532-8210
- ⊗ Electronics & Appliances - Contact your local appliance or electronics retailer OR watch for public announcements of the electronic and appliance recycling days offered by the Redwood County Environmental Office in the spring
