






















#### **Connecting Technology and Communities in Redwood County**

ave you ever thought about how much social media can help your business, your hobbies, or even your day to day activities? Have you ever thought about how Google can put you on the map? What about using your smart phone as a business tool? Redwood County has an option for you. **Redwood Connect** is working to bring Broadband Technology to your home and community through classes, internet connections, free computers and first class technology resources. The Blandin Foundation has supported this project through a 2-year grant that has funded a new Technology Training Center equipped with 12 computers located in the Redwood County Courthouse. Lunch-n-Learn Classes are held every second and fourth Wednesday from 11:30-1:00 p.m. and a Coffee and Computers session from 8:00-9:30 a.m. on the first and third Wednesdays of the month.

#### Redwood County Revolving Loan Fund

#### **County Board of Appeal and Equalization**

The process of Valuation and Classification begins each year with the County Assessor's Office placing a value and a classification on each parcel located in Redwood County as of January 2nd. The values for 2016 were based on sales that occurred during the sales study period of 10-01-14 through 9-30-15.

In March 2016 the Valuation Notice was mailed to each property owner informing them of the current value and classification for the 2016 assessment (that will be used for property taxes in 2017) along with their 2016 property tax statement. The back side of the Valuation Notice contains all the information for a property owner if they believe the classification or valuation is not correct. The Local Board of Appeal and Equalization meetings are held during the month of April.

On **June 21**<sup>st</sup> the County Board of Appeal and Equalization will be held at the Redwood County Government Center at **6:00 p.m**. The County Board of Appeal and Equalization is the meeting for any property owner who attended their Local Board of Appeal and Equalization Meeting to contest either their estimated market value or classification of the property they own and disagrees with the decision of the Local Board.

You must have presented your case to the Local Board of Appeal and Equalization <u>before</u> appealing to the County Board of Appeal and Equalization. You will need to call 507-637-4016 for an appointment.

#### **Get your Passport at Redwood County**

Passport books and cards can be applied for in the Administration Office at the Government Center. Passports are required for International travel only. The new MN REAL ID will not be needed for domestic flights until 2018.

You will need the following items:

- Passport Application
- Certified Birth Certificate
- Passport Picture
- Valid Driver's License or State ID
- Minors under age 16 must appear with both parents and the parents must have valid driver's license or state ID.

Note: The US Department of State is expecting an increase of passport applications through 2018. Submit your passport application well ahead of your planned travel dates in order to avoid possible delays. The current processing time is 6 weeks.

## GIS TO THE PUBLIC IS COMING SOON!!!


Have you ever wanted to access Redwood County maps and information from the comfort of your home, business, or in the field?

Redwood County has received a grant from the Blandin Foundation to help fund the creation of a public interactive mapping site. Redwood County has contracted with Schneider Corporation to purchase their Beacon™ product. Beacon™ is an interactive public access mapping tool that allows users to view a large amount of data in an interactive online environment. The simple to use Geographical Information Systems (GIS) mapping interface allows you to view spatial information consisting of, but not limited to, parcel information, county ditch and tile, specific districts, zoning, transportation, hydrology, etc. overlaid on high resolution aerial photography better than Google. Beacon™ also includes an array of navigation and analytical tools to help you find information faster.

The need to access local government data often occurs outside of normal office hours, and Beacon provides robust access through the web via cellular, tablets, and across other mobile devices when and where the users need it. Redwood County's Beacon Site will be available at:

You will need to enter Minnesota and Redwood County from the drop down menu. There will also be links on the Redwood County Website. If interested, training sessions will be scheduled on Redwood Connect. (See page 4 for more information).



#### **Don't Forget the Building Permit!!**

The Redwood County Environmental Office reminds property owners that Land Use/Zoning Permits (building permits) are required for all construction projects in the county. If you are planning a project, please contact the Redwood County Environmental staff prior to beginning construction in order to determine setbacks and other ordinance requirements that may apply.

People sometimes forget to apply for a building permit or don't think they need a permit for a small structure such as a deck, small shed, etc. However, permits are required for almost any construction project. Earth moving projects may also require a permit, as do grading or vegetation alterations in the Shoreland and Floodplain zoning districts. Additionally, be aware that, though a permit is not required to plant trees, trees are subject to setbacks from the road right of way as well as county ditches and tile.

Land Use/Zoning Permits that aren't obtained prior to construction are treated as "after the fact" permits subject to double the cost of the permit. Additionally, if the project fails to meet setbacks or other zoning regulations, a variance or conditional use permit may be required. These situations can often be avoided by making relatively minor changes to the project, when the applicant works with the Environmental Office from the start.

Though state law allows 60 days, the Environmental Office policy is to approve, or provide reasons for non-approval, within no more than 10 days of receipt of a complete Land Use/Zoning Permit application. So, make sure to apply for your Land Use/Zoning Permit early in order to avoid unnecessary delays or "after-the-fact" fees.

#### **Need a new Septic System?**

Does your septic system back up? Are your drains slow? Do you have sewage surfacing on the ground outside, or does your septic flow into a stream, creek or ditch? Does your septic tank leak? Are you thinking about building a home addition that could include a bedroom but you have an old septic system that is not compliant with current septic rules? Are you concerned that your septic doesn't protect the ground water?

If your answer to any of the above questions is "yes," then the Redwood County Environmental Office and the Redwood Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) can potentially provide funding to you to install a replacement septic system. Like everything else, new septic systems cost money, often in the \$8,000 to \$15,000 range depending on size and type. Luckily, the Environmental Office and SWCD have low interest loans and low income grants available for Redwood County landowners who need to replace their old or failing septic systems. These programs are funded by the State of Minnesota in order to ensure good water quality across the state.

Now is the time to replace your malfunctioning septic system. Call either of our offices today to begin the process. Funds are available on a first-come first-serve basis and septic systems can be installed now through fall, weather permitting.
