Guidelines for the proper separation and sorting of paper products in Redwood County.

In order to insure proper recycling of the many different types of paper, please sort your materials into the following categories. For most households, it is acceptable to combine the white bond and colored ledger paper, unless a large amount is generated. Businesses and schools should sort into all four of these categories and keep the material separate.

Newspaper

- Softwood paper Similar to Newsprint
- Discount Store Adds (Wal-Mart Etc)
- Uncoated Publications and Sale Flyers

Magazines/Glossy

- Coated Magazines
- Glossy Catalogs
- Shiny Add Brochures
- Glossy Coated Paper
- TV Guide & Auto Traders
- Phone Books
- Paperback Books

Colored Ledger Paper

- Colored Copy Paper
- Junk Mail & Window Envelopes
- Note Paper
- Church Bulletins & Greeting Cards
- File Folders & Manila Envelopes
- Carbonless Copy paper
- Colored Envelopes

White Bond

- White Note Pads
- Computer Paper
- Typing paper
- Adding Machine Tape
- Letterhead
- Uncoated Copy Paper
- White Windowless Envelopes
